**Tickets are available** in Cable at Big Brook Greenhouse, Firefly Trading Company, and the Cable Natural History Museum. Tickets will also be available at each of the gardens during the tour.

**Take a relaxing break and grab lunch** at the Rookery or Lakewoods Resort, which are located along the 25-mile driving loop.

**Join us for a post-tour reception** on the patio at the Cable Natural History Museum from 1:00 to 3:00 pm. Beverages and refreshments will be served and gardening demonstrations and experiences will be shared.
